- **Animal Licensing –**

Currently there are 145 dogs and 15 cats licensed.

- **Rabies Clinic – Saturday, February 8, 2020, 9:30am-11am**

All members offered to volunteer at the Rabies Clinic and will arrive at 9:00 am. Approximately 7-8 high school honor students will also arrive at the clinic at 9:00 am. Dr. Behan will administer the rabies vaccine. Cats are 9:30am–10am and dogs are 10am-11am. The Department of Public Works will set up the room the day before. The rabies clinic was advertised in the mailbag, Township email and flyers were placed in homeowners associations and around the Township.

Chairman Tredy requested enter and exit signs be printed to hang up at the Rabies Clinic and signs indicating what time dogs are and what time cats are. Secretary Giardino will print the signs out for clinic. Chairman Tredy can pick up the signs with the vaccine the night before. Secretary Giardino will open the building at 8:30am.
