RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF JOHN S. STEVENS, JR AS A CLASS II OFFICER FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Rogalski discussed Officer Stevens is a Lacey Township resident, a Lacey High School Graduate and is currently pursuing a college education studying psychology and criminal justice. Officer Stevens has currently served as a Class II Police Officer with the Avalon Police Department from June 2023 until September 2023 after graduating from the Cape May County Police Academy. In September of 2023 he was hired by the Middle Township Police Department, where he most recently served as a Class II Police Officer. In addition to his law enforcement experience Officer Stevens continued to be a practitioner in Brazilian Jujitsu and is very close to his Blue Belt. Officer Stevens will begin is Field Training Officer (FTO) training within the Patrol Division on nights, assigned to his training officer Van de Brook.

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF KYLE FARRELL AS A POLICE OFFICER FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Rogalski discussed Patrolman Farrell is a Barnegat resident, a graduate of Lacey Township High School and a graduate of Ocean County College. After high school, Patrolman Farrell enlisted in the United States Army where he served as an 11B Infantryman and attended basic combat training in Fort Benning Georgia. In 2021 he attended Reclassification Course in Fort Knox Kentucky and was reclassified as a 31E Military Police Correction and Detention Specialist. His military service spanned eight years which encompassed one overseas deployment to Guantanamo Bay Cuba 2021-2022. He was

subsequently honorably discharged at the rank of Sergeant after earning multiple Ribbons, two Certificates of Achievements, one for being a team leader of the Force Cell Extraction Team and General's Army Combat Fitness Test Top Ten Award. He received the Army Achievement Medal while mobilized overseas. Most recently, Kyle served three years with the Juvenile Justice Commission and worked as a Sheriff's Officer with the Burlington County Sheriff's Department. Kyle will begin his FTO training within the Patrol Division on days, assigned to his training officer Patrolman McKnight.
