Going on vacation? Leaving town for business? Whatever the reason, being away from your home for any length of time can lead to security concerns.

The Ocean Township Police Department House Watch program is designed to provide you with peace of mind by placing your address on an increased patrol list. Officers in your area will be instructed to conduct an exterior check of your residence daily. Our officers will send you an email daily to let you know your residence was checked and everything is okay.

Signing up for the House Watch program is as simple as clicking this link and filling out a few boxes.

If you are unable to enter your house to the list electronically you can do so by stopping into police headquarters 24 hours a day / 7 days a week at 50 Railroad Ave. in Waretown, NJ 08758.

Restrictions and Exclusions:

1. All Vacation / House Watch services of a residence will be for a minimum of (3) three days and a maximum of (4) four consecutive weeks.
2. Your residence must be located within Ocean Township limits.
3. All active real estate (sale/rental/lease) properties are excluded.
4. The residence must be vacated for the duration of leave in order to obtain a house watch. If someone will be staying or stopping at the residence, we CANNOT accept your house watch request.
5. The Ocean Township Police Department cannot guarantee your residence will be checked at a specific time each day, but every effort will be made to check your residence as time and workload allows. During the time(s) of a Natural Disaster (Hurricane, Flood, Ice Storm, Earthquake, etc....) all Vacation/House Watch services may be suspended.
